









# Low- and Moderate-Income Floridians in 2015 & Saturation of Civil Legal Aid Services



Service Saturation

Denser areas indicate greater number of closed civil legal aid cases per income eligible person

Poverty data is from the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey Estimates for 2015 by ZIP Code Tabulation Area (ZCTA). The areas in light grey are so sparsely populated that there are not enough residents to include in the Census Bureau's survey.

Service saturation is calculate using closed case data collected from The Florida Bar Foundation's civil legal aid organizations. ZIP codes were inferred from county for 5% of the 80,000 where ZIP codes were missing.
